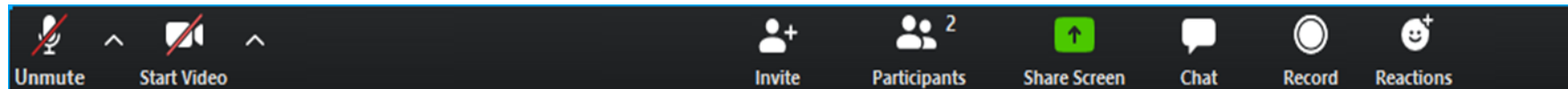

MA PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- 8.5 months long – 67 class sessions/268 contact hours
- Meets two nights a week (5pm – 9pm)
- Available in-person or online



DA PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- 3.5 months long – 130 contact hours and 40 hours working in a dental office
- Meets two nights a week (5pm – 9pm)
- Available in-person or online



UPCOMING COHORTS

- Medical Assistant Apprenticeship:
 - May 25 to February 2, 2023
 - Early September 2022 (date not set yet) to Fall, 2023
- Dental Assistant Apprenticeship:
 - August 4 to December 13, 2022 – **Applications open June 3 – June 17** (must apply)
 - Early January, 2023 (date not yet set)
